

# Focus on Peter Purcell "My Life as a Living Artist"

I was born in the distant regions of Te Awamutu. I don't know where it could have been, a hen's house or even a pig's sty! My twin brother Neil followed me on the 1st October 1943. I was adopted at birth and spent the war years at Fairy Springs, Ngotaha, Rotorua and arrived in Auckland in 1947.

I lived in Hearne Bay, Mason's Avenue and went to Bayfield School till 1952, where I was first introduced to art and produced a crayon drawing of pirates, after seeing a film at the Britannia Picture Theatre in Ponsonby. In January 1952, my father, William Kirwan Purcell died (born 1890). Thereafter, I went to Dilworth School and was an inmate from 1953 to 1960, ruled by Headmaster Brigadier Connolly DSO.

These years I spent reading history and invading all the picture theatres in Auckland, going to some 3 films in one day. Cowboy films at the Majestic, St James, Civic and all the others that Queen Street had in the 1950's. Most of my arty ideas came from this direction, including reading numerous comic books (classics bought from Whitcombe and Tombs. Once a fortnight, after attending church at St Marks, Remuera, we spent one day at home where I painted and listened to the "Diggers Session" on radio. Learnt all about warfare, wars of the 1914 – 1918 – 1939 – 1949.

During the school holidays I would buy toy soldiers from Farmers in Hobson Street with my pocket money and painted over 50 paintings on cardboard of Napoleonic Battles, wars of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and naval "Nelson Period". These paintings I still have, hidden under my 4 poster bed on which my mother died in her sleep in her 90<sup>th</sup> year. She too is in limbo land lying on top of Dad at Purewa Cemetery (died 1989), born 1/8/1900.

Because they were born in Victorian and Edwardian era's I was always surrounded by people of these eras. My mother's father was born in 1874 (NZ) and Dad's father came to NZ in 1848 and was born in the South Island in 1840. Dad's father fought against the Moari (1863 to 1865). They were the first white people to have children born in Rotorua outside of Ohinamuthu. My working years were from 1961 to 1990 at the CBA Bank and Westac. I retired aged 47 and during this period I painted and collected antiques of which I still have some today.

I have had 3 one man exhibitions and have won numerous awards and passed on a large number of paintings to both members of WCCAC and other gentry who have taken to my art like ducks to water or bees to a beehive. Especially when Rupert the Bear appears hidden away in my colourful works of fantasy as Historical Art.
